

A.A.S. Cooperative Degree Agreement

Valdosta State University And Wiregrass Georgia Technical College

General Information:

The cooperative agreement between Valdosta State University (VSU) and Wiregrass Georgia Technical College (WGTC) provides students an opportunity to continue their education and obtain an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree from VSU, after completing graduation requirements at WGTC.

The A.A.S degree consists of 24 semester hours of general education and related academic coursework from Valdosta State University, and successful completion of an approved program at Wiregrass Technical College.

Note: Of these 24 hours, 21 must be taken in residence at Valdosta State University in order to be eligible for graduation. Additionally, the student will be required to complete both parts of the Regents' test satisfactorily prior to graduation from Valdosta State University

The A.A.S degree in Dental Hygiene is recognized to have additional coursework beyond that of other specialties. Please see either the Valdosta State University or Wiregrass Georgia Technical College website for more information.
