Section 485 (a) and (f) of the Higher Education Act (also known as the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act) (20 U.S.C. 1092 (a) and (f)) requires this institution to report to you annually on campus security and crime statistics.

From July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2009, there were no reported incidents of the following crimes: murder, manslaughter, sex offenses, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, motor vehicle theft, arson, crimes involving bodily injury, hate crimes, illegal weapons possession, drug law violation, or liquor law violation.
