

## Park University

### Criminal Justice Technology - Criminal Justice Administration (effective August 22, 2011)

This agreement provides students who have earned a specific **Associate of Applied Science degree** at Wiregrass Georgia Technical College the opportunity to complete a **Bachelor of Science** at Park University. Any WGTC student who has earned an Associate of Applied Science degree, and adheres to the guidelines within the joint articulation agreement, are guaranteed that Park will accept designated freshman and sophomore education credits, and all general education credits, and will apply such to the Bachelor of Science degree in a manner consistent with the treatment of native Park students.

#### Conditions of Transfer:

- 1. Admissions and Matriculation** - WGTC students will be afforded the same treatment and protection, and be required to meet the same admission requirements, as native Park students enrolled under a specific catalog. WGTC students should request an official transcript be sent to Park University upon completion of coursework at Wiregrass Georgia Technical College. A minimum grade of "C" in all courses must be maintained to qualify for transfer under this articulation agreement.
- 2. Transfer of Credit** - A maximum of 75 semester hours will be accepted by Park from WGTC. Transfer students from WGTC, upon acceptance into the appropriate program at Park, will have junior level standing at Park University.
- 3. Program Plan** - This agreement presumes that the general education core requirements at WGTC meet all freshmen and sophomore level university studies requirements of Park. Students falling under this program articulation agreement will be responsible for successfully completing the prescribed requirements.
