

Point University and Wiregrass Georgia Technical College

Bachelors of Science

INTRODUCTION:

This agreement formally recognizes that Point University and Wiregrass Georgia Technical College (WGTC) are active partners in providing educational opportunities for currently enrolled and potential students enrolled in their respective institutions. Agreement to this partnership requires a commitment by all parties to serve and facilitate a student's ability to transfer into a degree without jeopardizing the intended mission and stated goals of Point University or Wiregrass Georgia Technical College.

PURPOSE:

Point University and Wiregrass Georgia Technical College are entering into an articulation agreement to assist in the transferability of credit hours from students who have earned an associate degree through Wiregrass Georgia Technical College to a bachelors of science degree available online at Point University.

AGREEMENT:

Under this agreement, students from WGTC who earn an associate degree are eligible to pursue a Bachelor of Science degree from Point University in any of the bachelors of science degree programs offered online through Point University.

GUIDELINES FOR TRANSFER OF CREDIT:

The following guidelines are used to award credit towards a degree bachelors of science degree offered through the online program at Point University. Credit courses earned towards an associate degree at WGTC, except for sub 100 level coursework, may be transferable to a bachelor's degree offered through Point University's online degree programs in the following manner:

1. General Education course work at the associate degree level in which the student has earned a "C" grade or higher may be transferred providing Point University offers a comparable course. General education courses are transferrable according to the existing Georgia Independent College Association – Technical College System of Georgia articulation agreement.

2. Additional coursework earned towards an associate degree at WGTC may be eligible for transfer as electives into one of the online programs offered through Point University according to transfer policies published in the - University catalog.
3. Point University will accept credit earned through dual enrollment from WGTC. Students presenting CLEP transfer credit must also submit official transcripts of the credit from the testing agency from which it was earned.
4. Up to 60 semester credit hours may be transferred to an online degree program at Point University. Registered Nursing graduates may transfer up to 66 hours in the RN-BSN completion program. Transfer credits may differ/vary depending on which online degree program the student chooses to enter.
5. Point University and the Wiregrass Georgia Technical College agree to review this agreement bi-annually to ensure continued transfer compatibility of programs of study.
6. Completion of an associate degree at WGTC does not guarantee admission to Point University or to any degree program offered through Point University. Some programs at Point University may have additional admission requirements which students must meet to be eligible for admission. Students must meet all admission requirements for admission to Point University and for the selected program of study. Students who have not completed program pre-requisites (if required) must complete those at Point University or other appropriate institutions before admission to the program of choice.
7. Wiregrass Georgia Technical College and Point University agree to promote this agreement to eligible students.

TERMS OF RENEWAL OR TERMINATION:

The articulation agreement will be renewed bi-annually with the consensus of both parties. Either party may make adjustments to course equivalents as is necessary to continue the transferability of coursework. Either party may terminate their participation in this Agreement upon giving written notice to the other. Written notification should be received at least three months before the renewal date of the articulation agreement.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AGREEMENT:

Terms of this agreement will be effective beginning July 1st 2019 and will renew automatically unless either party terminates the agreement as outlined in the Terms of Renewal or Termination listed above.
